COMMITTEE MEETING
MARCH 30, 2006

A meeting of the Blackhills Camp Council Executive Committee was held at Fairmont Free Methodist Church on March 30, 2006.

Mike Shahan opened with prayer.

Those in attendance were: Mike Shahan, Ken Walter, Faith Reesman, Cheryl Kennedy, Minter Foster Lisa McIntyre and Superintendent Chet Martin via telephone.

Review of camp fees:

- A fee schedule for Family Camp 2005 and a proposed fee schedule for Family Camp 2006 were reviewed and discussed.
- 2005 Family Camp Financial Reports were reviewed and discussed.
- Discussed and reviewed the Wabash Fee List and an example of a Registration Form

Development of New Fee Structure:

- Reviewed and discussed the budget for all 2006 camps.
- The committee proposed a camp lot fee of \$20, RV/Cabins/Room fee of \$25, Registration fee of \$5 per person for 2 nights or more for 2006 and a lot fee of \$40, RV/Cabin/Room fee of \$50, and Registration fee of \$10 per person beginning in 2007.
- Reviewed and discussed meal ticket fee schedule - proposed to increase the adult meal ticket by \$5, increase weekend meal ticket by \$5 and the individual meal ticket by \$1.

Review of Family Camp Housing List

- Reviewed e-mail from Faith Reesman to Mike Shahan showing the waiting list for units at camp. Each person will be contacted regarding their request for units.
- Who will maintain the housing list? (Keeper of List of occupied and available rooms, assigning rooms before and during camp) -Suggestions: Jack Lemley or Julie Foster. Jack Lemley will be contacted prior to the April 17 Camp Council meeting.
- Discussed housing request from Princeton Church-Mike Shahan will call Ken Hilling and advise him of options and then meet with trustees to assess the unit and see what needs done to fix it up.
